- Each facility has a designated Infection Preventionist who:
  - Completes a 19-hour training course specific to long term care
  - Has training developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
    (CDC) in partnership with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- The Infection Preventionist is responsible for:
  - Overseeing the facility Infection Control and Antibiotic Stewardship Programs
  - Collaborating with the Medical Director on facility infection control measures and processes
  - Monitoring facility, resident, or other infections
  - Tracking, trending, and analyzing Infection and Antibiotic data
  - Actively participating in the facility Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement (QAPI) program
  - Educating facility on infection control
  - Updating current infection control guidelines into facility's infection control program
  - Collaborating and communicating with the local county and state health departments
  - Maintaining the employee health program
